



## Travel & Other Information

### **Getting There!**

The Don CeSar hotel is located approximately 30 minutes from Tampa International Airport (TPA) and 25 minutes from St. Petersburg/Clearwater International Airport (PIE). Transportation options, from the airport include rental cars, shared-ride vans and taxis. The hotel does not offer a complimentary shuttle service, however, NSEE recommends the shuttle service as the most economical form of transportation to and from both airports.

### **Shuttle Service:**

10 person shared van service is available at the airport  
Tickets can be purchased outside of baggage claim for \$25 per person  
*Please be aware shuttles make up to 10 stops and have longer commute times.*

### **Taxi:**

Approximately \$80-\$85 each way from the Tampa Airport  
Approximately \$85 each way from the St. Petersburg/Clearwater Airport

### **Private Town Car:**

\$65 for arrival, \$60 for return to airport
